

FORFEITURE OF UNIVERSITY STUDIES

Forfeiture of studies occurs when no proficiency examinations are taken for a period of eight consecutive academic years.

The payment of the all-inclusive contribution (fees) does not interrupt or postpone the forfeiture period even in the case of duly paid fees. Forfeiture is triggered when the indicated conditions are met.

A student who has completed all the teaching activities and is only in default of the *final examination* never forfeits his or her degree and may graduate by regularising his or her administrative position with the Registrar's Office.

NEW CAREER - REQUEST FOR RECOGNITION

A student with a forfeited career who wishes to embark on a new university course at Unimore **may enrol in the new degree programme** (with the reference FORFEITED Student) and may **generally** request recognition of the teaching activities undertaken in the career closed for forfeiture. Recognition is a discretionary act that requires the **evaluation of previous careers** and the approval of the Departmental Council and is governed by the Teaching Regulations of the study programmes.
