- A statement/certification issued by the competent foreign higher education institution detailing the contents and activities of the doctoral programme undertaken to obtain the final degree, as well as the duration of the programme in years. If the foreign system provides a Diploma Supplement, this document is also required.
- Documentation required for the verification of the authenticity of the foreign qualification, such as verification statements issued by the Italian ENIC-NARIC centre (CIMEA), or legalization of documents (e.g. Hague Apostille, where applicable).
- A copy of the doctoral thesis and/or the web address of the university repository or library where the approved thesis is stored and accessible, or the contact details of the relevant office where the thesis can be accessed for verification purposes.

- A copy of the second-cycle degree (Italian or foreign) that granted access to the foreign doctoral programme, and the contact details of the institution that issued the degree and can confirm the submitted documentation.
- (Optional) Any translations into Italian of the required documents.
- (Optional) Any additional documentation, such as a CV, reference letters, etc.
