

“UniMORE” GRADUATION AWARD CALL FOR APPLICATIONS
(Academic Year 2024/2025)

For the 2024/2025 academic year, the University shall award 70 graduation awards, each amounting to €700.00, to particularly deserving graduates who obtained their degree in the 2024/2025 academic year (within the extraordinary graduation session). The number of awards allocated to each Department is based on the proportional distribution of students and is calculated according to the number of enrolled students as of June 2026.

The awards are intended for graduates who meet the following requirements:

- **Award of the degree in the 2024/2025 academic year.**

Throughout their degree programme, students must not have been enrolled as repeat students or students beyond the standard duration of the programme, or have interrupted or suspended their academic career, except in the cases provided for by the relevant teaching regulations.

Students who are interested and meet the above requirements **may submit their application online** by accessing their personal page at **www.esse3.unimore.it**.

Applications must be submitted exclusively online as indicated above by **1 p.m. on 30 November 2026 at the latest**. At the end of the online procedure, an application submission receipt will be made available. Students must retain this receipt as proof of participation in the award procedure; no delivery to any office is required.

The provisional ranking list for the graduation awards will be published on **13 May 2027** in the UniMORE Online Register. On the same date, information concerning any appeals and the publication of the final ranking lists will be provided. The ranking list will be drawn up in descending order according to the following criteria:

1. degree mark;
2. honours (cum laude);
3. weighted average used for admission to the final degree examination;
4. graduation session closest to the date of enrolment;
5. younger age.

If, due to a lack of eligible students, any awards remain unassigned, they shall be allocated according to a single University-wide ranking list.

The UniMORE Graduation Award 2024/2025 is incompatible with other graduation awards and/or study awards granted by UniMORE having the same characteristics and purposes.

The award shall be paid following verification of the eligibility requirements and exclusively by bank transfer to a current account/card with an IBAN associated with the student and held in the student's name. For the assessment of merit, checks, withdrawal and penalties, reference shall be made to the provisions contained in the Call for Applications for Benefits for the Right to University Education.
